—A life-long resident of Churchville, Mrs. A.M. Gage, died yesterday morning, from heart failure. She was born in Churchville, October 5, 1814, the daughter of Elisha P. and Fanny Davis, and the wife of Dr. M.B. Gage, who died in 1876. A brother, George T. Davis, resides in Bergen. Her surviving children are: Homer L. Gage, of Bergen; Mrs. Ann M. Welch, of Churchville, and Mrs. Frances M. Balcom, of Kendall. The funeral will be held at her late residence Saturday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock.

—Mrs. Ann M. Gage, mother of Homer L. Gage, and sister of George T. Davis, who died at Churchville Wednesday morning at 3:15, aged 77 years, was the widow of Dr. M.B. Gage of Bergen who died in 1876, and spent 20 years of her life in this town. Since 1883 she had resided in Churchville, in which village she was born. Her last illness was of about four weeks' duration and the end came suddenly and apparently painlessly while she was sitting in a chair. Her daughter, Mrs. Welch, lived with her, and another daughter, Mrs. Mahlon Balcom, lives in Kendall. Mrs. Gage was a member of the Universalist church and was a great favorite with all who knew her, children as well as adults. The Rev. Dr. [Asa] Saxe of Rochester, assisted by the Rev. William Furman, the Congregational minister, will conduct funeral services at the house tomorrow afternoon at 3:30.
