McGrawville, July 8.—We clip the following from the Jonesville (Michigan) Independent: "Died—at his home in Fayette, June 20, 1892, Philip Schuyler Gaige, aged 83 years. Mr. Gaige came to Michigan in 1835, settled on a farm in Litchfield for a few years, and then removed to the farm on which he died. He has lived in this vicinity longer than any man now living, who was a man when he came here. Mr. Gaige left a large property. In religion he was a believer in the Universalist faith. In politics he was a Democrat, never voting anything but a straight Democratic ticket." Mr. Gaige was well known here. He left four daughters. He was the son of Squire Gaige, who lived on the Rawley farm in Solon. He married Emily Mahan, oldest sister of Mrs. Rosetta Bingham, who lived at Blodgett Mills, on the Charles Copeland farm.
