Mrs. Mina Galloway Dead at 82

SACKETS HARBOR—Mrs. Mina J. Salisbury Galloway, 82, widow of Harold G.[F.] Galloway, died unexpectedly 10 p.m. Sunday at the home of a nephew, Schuyler Colwell, Salt Point road, Watertown, R.D. 1, where she was spending the winter.

Although having a heart condition, she had been in her usual health and able to be around. Surviving are a grandson, Brandt O. Galloway, Orange City, Fla., and four great grandchildren. Her only child, Clifford S. Galloway, died Nov. 4, 1948.

Mrs. Galloway was born Nov. 7, 1884 in the town of Hounsfield, a daughter of Schuyler A. and Rozella Miner Salisbury. She was married June 30 1903 to Harold Galloway in the manse of All Souls Universalist church, Watertown. Mr. Galloway, a native of Sackets Harbor, operated a farm at 1275 Coffeen street, Watertown for 83 years. He sold it about 1941, then operated a farm at Chestnut Ridge for eleven years until his retirement. He died Nov. 23, 1964. Mrs. Galloway was a member of All Souls Universalist church, Watertown and Brownville chapter, O.E.S.
