GEORGE H. GALLUP

Dolgeville—George H. Gallup died Saturday at his home on Van Buren Street.

He was born in Wells, Hamilton County, Mar. 31, 1873, the son of the late Henry and Elizabeth Hillock Gallup. For the past 15 years he had resided in this village, where he was employed by the Dolgeville Slipper Company.

He is survived by his wife, who was formerly Lena Bishop; by three sons, Lloyd Gallup of Herkimer, Robert of Gloversville, and Albertus, who is in the U.S. Navy; by a daughter, Mrs. Pearl Cool, of this place; by two brothers, Edward and Raymond Gallup of New York City, and by a half-brother, Ralph Dingman of Gloversville.

The funeral will be held from the home at 11 tomorrow morning, the Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton of the Universalist church officiating, and burial will be in the family plot in the cemetery at Broadalbin.
