George Nathan Gallup, 54, died Saturday night after a long illness, at the home of his sister, Mrs. Durward H. Everett, 52 Chedell Place. Mr. Gallup was born May 13, 1861, in Macedon, a son of the late Silas N. and Carrie Turner Gallup. For some years Mr. Gallup was employed by the old F. W. Richardson Company as an interior decorator. In 1908 he went to New Orleans where he resided for 23 years. He returned to Auburn three years ago. Mr. Gallup was a member of the Daubers Club of this city and the Louisiana State Sons of the American Revolution.

Besides his sister, Mrs. Everett, surviving are a grand niece, Miss Alice W. Everett of Dobbs Ferry, N.Y.; two nephews, Julian G. Everett of Dobbs Ferry and Nathan G. Everett of Louisville, Ky., formerly of this city.

Funeral services will be held at 1 o'clock Tuesday afternoon at 52 Bedell Place. Burial will be at Macedon. Rev. Plato T. Jones, pastor of First Universalist Church, will officiate.
