DIED FROM INJURIES INFLICTED BY BULL  
John B. Galusha Had Many Friends in Community

Dolgeville, Feb. 23.—John Burr Galusha., who was crushed against the side of the barn at his home by a bull Saturday afternoon, died yesterday of the injuries he received. Mr. Galusha was 62 years of age. He had resided in this section all of his life, and was well known to people of this vicinity as a man of integrity, genial personality and worthy character. He is survived by his wife and three daughters, Mrs. John Hicks, Mrs. William Douglass and Miss Sarah Galusha. The funeral is to be held from the late home of Mr. Galusha, in the town of Oppenheim, at 2 o'clock Thursday afternoon, the Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton of the Universalist Church of this village officiating.
