Mrs. Sarah Frances Gein, 74, wife of George Gein of 3057 Bedford avenue, and member of one of the oldest families of this borough, died on Saturday of heart trouble after a year's illness. The funeral was held today, with interment in Mount Olivet Cemetery, following service conducted by the Rev. Dr. Thomas Edward Potterton, pastor of the Church of Our Father, of which she was a member. Mrs. Gein was born in lower Brooklyn and was the daughter of the late Philo P. and Sarah F. Foote. Her father was a feed and grain merchant of old Brooklyn. In her early life Mrs. Gein was connected with the First Universalist Church, and later, work of the Church of Our Father. She married forty-eight years ago, and in addition to her husband, who is retired, she leaves two sons, William and George Jr.; two daughters, Mrs. Philip H. Brooks and Mrs. Irving J. Allen, with whom she lived; two brothers, Edward F. Foote of Richfield Park, N.J., and Charles T. Foote of Brooklyn, and a sister, Miss Susie L Foote of Fishkill, N.Y.
