Lewis Gibson

After a long period of invalidism due to a serious heart ailment Lewis Gibson passed away Tuesday of last week at about midnight at the Fox Memorial Hospital in Oneonta, where he had been a patient for several days.

Mr. Gibson, only son of Royal and Louisa Wilson Gibson was born July 3, 1877 in the town of Pittsfield on the Gibson homestead where he had resided through early manhood, tenderly caring for his parents and operating the farm after they became too infirm to do so. Shortly after his marriage twenty-five years ago to Mrs. Nora Carver Clifford, Mr. Gibson came to Morris to live and here spent the remainder of his life.

Mr. Gibson was a good workman and occupied various positions of trust during his lifetime. A man of unusual kindness of heart, always ready to assist any in time of need, he leaves many friends to cherish his memory.

The immediate surviving relatives are a sister, Mrs. Alvin Gifford of Morris and several cousins, to all of whom sincere sympathy is extended.

Funeral services, conducted by the Rev. F. [Fred] G. Leonard of the Universalist church were held in Sloan's funeral parlors Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Interment in the family plot in Hillington cemetery.
