MRS. HARRIET GILCHRIST DIES AFTER LONG ILLNESS
Widow of Former Oswego Grocer—
Active in Universalist Church Work—
Survived by Niece

OSWEGO, Nov. 3.—Mrs. Harriet E. Gilchrist, the latter for many years one of the leading grocers of the city, died at the family home, No. 112 East Fourth street, this afternoon after an illness of several months. She was active in the Universalist Church Society here.

She was born in Hannibal, but came to this city with her parents at an early age and lived here most of her life.

The funeral will probably be held Monday afternoon. A niece, Mrs. W. E. [Harriet] Armbrecht, survives.
