HATTIE E. GILCHRIST

Hattie E. Gilchrist, wife of Rev. H. E. [Elmer] Gilchrist, of Fort Plain, N.Y., died at 9 Monday evening. Mrs. Gilchrist will be buried from the home of her brother, H. G. Farmer, in Gouverneur, Thursday afternoon, at 2. Interment will be in the family plot in Riverside Cemetery, Gouverneur.

Mrs. Gilchrist was born in Canton, and received her education at the Canton Academy and St. Lawrence University. Rev. Mr. Gilchrist met his future wife while he was a student in the Theological seminary of St. Lawrence University, and soon after his graduation, about 30 years ago, they were married.

Rev. Mr. Gilchrist has had charges in Provincetown, Mass., New Orleans, La., and Oneida. Mrs. Gilchrist was a woman of high ideals and intellectual attainments and was highly regarded.

Mrs. Gilchrist is survived by her husband; two daughters, Madeline and Frances Gilchrist; four brothers, N. E. and Dr. G. S. Farmer, of this city; H. G. Farmer, of Gouverneur, and F. A. Farmer, of Syracuse.
