MRS. GILES R. GILL PASSES AT HER HOME

Mrs. Rhoda Ann Billings Gill, wife of Giles Rolla Gill, died at 5:35 Saturday evening at her home, 21 Clark Street, after an illness of several years from rheumatism and heart trouble. She was, however, confined to her bed only three days before her death. The funeral will be held at 1:30 today from the home, Rev. Emerson H. Lalone, pastor of the Universalist Church, officiating. Burial was made in Evergreen Cemetery.

Mrs. Gill was born in Canada Nov. 2, 1855, and came to this state with her parents at the age of six. She was married at Fine Jan. 13, 1889 to Giles Rolla Gill. The couple spent most of their lives in this village, where for a number of years, Mr. Gill was employed by the late R. T. Wells.

She is survived by her husband; a son, Howard Gill of Remsen; daughter, Mrs. Minnie Goodale, Sackets Harbor; sister, Mrs. Chas. Stone, Canton, R.F.D. There are also ten grandchildren and thirteen great-grandchildren.
