Mrs. Ellen A. Gillett, 85, died at 2:30 a.m. Friday, Nov. 25 at the Raybrook Sanatorium at Saranac Lake where she had been a [several missing words] Hampton, Mass., July 11, 1884, the daughter of the late Joseph and Betty Gillett. Her family moved to Canton when she was 16 years old. She was married to Charles A. Gillett here on Dec. 5, 1902. The couple always made Canton their home. Mrs. Gillett was a member of Canton Universalist Church.
