Residents of this village were saddened by the death of Miss Dorothy Gimán [Gilman], daughter of Mr and Mrs. George Gimán [Gilman], which occurred last Friday night at her home on Van Buren street and was caused by heart trouble, from which she had suffered for some time. The deceased was born in Los Angeles, February 5, 1910, and had lived in this place 10 years. She was a student of the local high school up to last January and was a member of the Girl Reserves and the Senior Clara Barton Guild. She was a popular girl, loved by all for her beautiful character and winning disposition. She leaves her parents; three sisters, [Mrs.] Edward Conyne and Miss Winifred Gilman of this village and Mrs. Charles Rubert of Hallsville; and three brothers, George, Jr., Donald and Robert Gilman of this place.
