Miss Catherine Amanda Goff, who died on Tuesday at her home, 10 Myrtle avenue, as briefly announced in the Times-Press, Wednesday evening, had been ill nine days with pneumonia. She was born at West Springfield, Mass., October 27, 1884, a daughter of George M. and Hermione Goff.

For about 30 years she had been a resident of this city. She attended the schools here until entering the employ of the Millen-Aikenhead Company, on Academy avenue, where she was a faithful employee.

Miss Goff was a member of Christ Church, Universalist, and also of Review, No. 302, W. B. A. of M. She was ever solicitous for the comfort and welfare of others and will be greatly missed by all who knew her.

The surviving members of the family are her mother, and the following brothers and sisters: George Ovid, Elbert Mortimer, Hermione G., Beatrice Amelia, and Edith Mildred. A sister, Flora, died in infancy, and a brother, Emery, was drowned in 1913 at the age of 14 years.
