OBITUARY

MRS. EMMA A. GOLDEN, wife of the late Augustus Golden, passed away at her home on Garden street last Saturday. Mrs. Golden was apparently in good health when on Wednesday night she suffered a stroke of paralysis, and did not regain consciousness. Mrs. Golden was born March 23, 1845, in the Burt Settlement, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Ira Eysaman. She was united in marriage to Augustus Golden March 11, 1863, who was for many years in the grocery trade in this city. Mrs. Golden was a woman of lovely character, devoted to her family and always interested in whatever was right and true. She was an attendant at the Universalist church. She is survived by two sons, Harry of Schenectady and Welford of Buffalo, and a brother, Henry Eysaman of the town of Little Falls. The funeral was held yesterday afternoon at 2:30, Rev. Mr. Cary officiating.
