Death of William R. Gordon, an Old Resident of Churchville

William R. Gordon, an old and well-known resident of the village of Churchville, died at the residence of his daughter, Mrs. H. G. Edwards, yesterday morning. Mr. Gordon was born at Newark, but had been a resident of the town of Riga for more than sixty years, having resided for some time on a farm two miles north of the village. For the greater part of his lifetime he had been employed as a salesman for a dry goods firm, but retired from business several years ago. He was married to Miss Jane Sprague, of Riga, who died about thirty years ago. The deceased was 82 years old and was a member of the Universalist Church of Churchville. His death was caused by paralysis, from which he suffered [after] a stroke some months ago. He is survived by two daughters, Mrs. James Harkness and Mrs. H. G. Edwards, of Churchville, and one son, William R. Gordon of Buffalo.
