MRS. EMMA GREELEY

Mrs. Emma Greeley, 73, widow of William Greeley, died yesterday at St. Mary's Hospital, Amsterdam, where she was taken for treatment earlier in the morning. She had been ill for the past few days.

She was born in the Town of Minden, June 19, 1871, daughter of Sidney and Ellen (Hurdic?) Smith. She had been a resident here for over 50 years. She was a member of the Fort Plain unit of the American Legion Auxiliary and the Universalist Church.

The survivors are two daughters, Mrs. Emiel Leneker, Fort Plain; Mrs. James R. Nelson, Albany; one son, William Greeley, Albany; six grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

The body was removed to the Gray funeral home, where funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon at 2:30. The Rev. Warren B. Lovejoy, pastor of the Universalist Church, will officiate. Burial will be made in the Fort Plain Cemetery.
