AUTO CRASH IN DOLGEVILLE IS FATAL TO GIRL
Bessie Green, 15, Passes Away at Little Falls Hospital
SEEMAN SENTENCED
Herkimer Man to Spend 90 Days in Jail for Leaving Scene of Crash

Bessie Green, 15, of Dolgeville, passed away in the Little Falls hospital at 10:30 Wednesday evening from injuries suffered, when an auto owned by C. Bleekman, of Herkimer crashed into a tree on Main street in Dolgeville early Wednesday morning. Coroner J. Graves of Little Falls has ordered an inquest for this afternoon to determine the circumstances surrounding the accident in which the girl was injured.

Andrew Seeman, 26, of Herkimer was arrested by Chief Youker of Dolgeville yesterday in connection with the accident. He was arraigned before Justice of the Peace Cramer in Dolgeville during the day on a charge of leaving the scene of an accident without making a report. He pleaded guilty and was sentenced to 90 days in the Herkimer county jail.

In the meantime authorities in the village are continuing their investigation. The authorities declared yesterday there appears to be some question as to who was driving the machine at the time of the accident. Bleekman and J. McArthur, of Salisbury Center were in the the machine at the time. Seeman disappeared immediately after the machine hit the tree.

Miss Green is survived by her father and two brothers, Harry and Raymond Green, of Dolgeville. Funeral services will be held at the home, North Elmer avenue, Saturday afternoon at 2:30. Rev. C. A. Morgan [Clinton A. Moulton], pastor of the Universalist church will officiate. Interment will be made in the family plot in the Dolgeville cemetery.
