George R. Green, 77, for 38 years a merchant and much of that time postmaster in South Rutland, died at his home there at 9 o'clock Sunday morning, following a stroke which he suffered about a week ago. Mr. Green retired from business in 1928, on account of his health, since which time he had gradually failed. He was born in the town of Pinckney, Sept. 26, 1855, a son of the late Return and Mary Waite Green, and had spent all his life in Lewis and Jefferson counties. He was for many years a member of Orient Lodge, No. 228, F. and A. M., of this village. Members of the lodge attended the funeral. In early life Mr. Green married Miss Emma Canfield, who survives, together with one son, Floyd L. Green, Watertown, and two daughters, Mrs. Edward Booth, Watertown, and Mrs. Clarence B. Bibbins of South Rutland, and six grandchildren. Funeral services were held at the home in South Rutland at 1 Wednesday, Rev. Harry Westbrook Reed [Universalist] of Watertown officiating. Interment was in Maplevue Cemetery, Rutland.
