MRS. CHARLES GREEN DIES IN ROCHESTER

Mrs. Mattie Gruman Brainard Green, 86, who died at the home of her son, Lynn J. Green, Rochester, Sunday, after an illness of three months, was a native of this place.

Mattie Gruman was born in Clinton December 18, 1846, a daughter of the late Edwin and Jerushie Carpenter Gruman. She was married to Daniel A. Brainard in 1865. He died in 1874. Three years later she was married to Charles C. Green, prominent hop dealer, who died in 1907. Two sons survive, Lynn, Rochester, Louis D. Brainard, Rome.

Mrs. Green was a resident of Utica where she was a member of the Universalist Church and was also associated with the D.A.R., Women's Christian Association and New Century Club. She was also a member of the board of directors of the Old Ladies' Home.
