Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday from the Chapman Funeral Home, with the Rev. Lyman Achenbach, pastor of St. Paul's Universalist Church, officiating. Interment will be in Tuttle Cemetery, Salisbury, in the spring.

Calling hours at the funeral home will be from 2 to 4 and 7 to 9 p.m. tomorrow. Members of the Dolgeville Masonic Lodge will meet at the Temple at 7 p.m. tomorrow to go in a group to the funeral home for ritualistic services at 8.
