JOHN W. GREENWOOD DIES

ALBION, Aug. 21.—John W. Greenwood, 63, of 85 Clinton street, died Tuesday. He was a native of England and came to Orleans county 40 years ago. Mr. Greenwood was a stone cutter by trade and for many years had taken an active part in both the stone cutters and paving cutters' unions. He was the first secretary in Orleans county of the paving cutters' union when that branch of the international union was formed. At the time of his death he was superintendent of the Sabbath school of the Pullman Memorial Universalist church, in which he had been an active worker for years. Mr. Greenwood leaves his wife, Mrs. Mary H. Greenwood; a son, Lincoln S. Greenwood, Des Moines, Iowa; three daughters, Mrs. Arthur Holt of Buffalo, Mrs. H. H. Curtis of Rochester and Miss Ida Greenwood of Albion, and a grandchild, Miss Corralyn Greenwood, Des Moines. The funeral, Thursday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, will be held in Pullman Memorial Universalist church, Rev. L. [Lewis] H. Robinson officiating. Burial will be in Mt. Albion cemetery.
