W. Gregg Gridley Succumbs After a Brief Illness  
Funeral Services This Afternoon, With Interment in Fayetteville

FAYETTEVILLE—W. Gregg Gridley, a life resident of this vicinity died Tuesday in a Syracuse hospital after a short illness. He was general agent of the Farmers & Traders Life Insurance Co. in Syracuse, a position he had held since 1928.

He was the son of Mrs. Lillian Gridley and the late Oliver Gridley, and was born in the Gridley farm about three miles east of Fayetteville. He was graduated from the Virginia Military Institute in 1921 and moved to Syracuse following his marriage to Miss Laura Reese of Rochester. He later moved to DeWitt, where he had since resided.

Only recently he purchased the Frank Hale homestead on the Syracuse road and was remodeling it for a home.

Surviving are his wife, his mother, one son, Webster; two daughters, Laura and Helen; three sisters, Mrs. Russell Laragh, Mrs. Seward Bucklin of DeWitt and Mrs. Donald Spaulding of Moravia; two brothers, O. Gates Gridley and Daniel Gridley, both of Fayetteville.

Funeral services will be conducted at the late home his afternoon at 2:30, Rev. Ellsworth Reamon of Betts Memorial [Universalist] Church officiating. Burial will be in Fayetteville cemetery.
