GRIFFIN.— Mrs. Lillie J. Griffin, wife of Dr. L. M. Griffin, died in Boulder, Col., of spino-meningitis, May 2d, 1887, aged 32 years and ten months. She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Chas. Forrester, of Hammond, where she was married some 12 years ago and moved to Colorado six years ago. Her husband practiced his profession also in Hammond and Rossie. She left two boys, 10 and 5 years old. She was a good woman, faithful in all the relations of life. She was a member of the Universalist church in Hammond and adorned her Christian profession with a well-ordered life. She passed quietly, peacefully away, welcoming the messenger that came to deliver her from the pains and sorrows of this world and introduce her to the higher life. Funeral services were held in the church at Hammond on the Sunday following her death by Rev. J. S. Lee, of Canton, when a large assemblage of relatives and friends filled the church.
