GREENWOOD WOMAN DIES AFTER LONG SICKNESS

Canisteo, June 8.—Mrs. Stella Griswold, 72 years old, descendant of one branch of the Stephens family, pioneer settlers of the Canisteo valley, died at 7 o'clock last evening at her home in Greenwood where she had been a life long resident. She had been in poor health for the past ten years and for the past two weeks her condition had been critical. Arterial sclerosis was the cause of death.

The deceased was born and had always lived in Greenwood where she was well known and liked. During the past years of her illness her son had been living with her.

She is survived by one son, Harvey Goodhue of Greenwood; one granddaughter, Mrs. James Hendee of this village; one grandson, Raymond Goodnoe of Greenwood; one sister, Mrs. Mary Young of Greenwood and one half sister, Mrs. Sarah Richey of Edgewater, Calif. The funeral will take place Friday afternoon at the home at two o'clock, Rev. Clara E. Morgan of the Woodbury Universalist church, officiating. Burial will be made in the Greenwood cemetery.
