WILLIAM E. GROSE

Little Falls—William E. Grose, 75, died Tuesday night at his home, 32 West Main Street, following an illness from complications since last September.

He was born in Troy, June 30, 1858, son of John and Martha Casler Grose. When he was a lad his parents came to reside and since then he had lived here. He was a charter member of the local Maccabees Tent and attended the Universalist Church. His last place of employment was at the Phoenix Mills, where he worked for 25 years. Early in life he was employed on the New York Central Railroad.

Last July 10 he and his wife, whose maiden name was Sarah (Bealer?), celebrated their golden wedding anniversary. She survives with two daughters, Mrs. Martha Roberts, this city; and Mrs. Flossom Gilbert, Newville; three sons, John, Bert and George Grose, all of Little Falls; three brothers, James and Charles, this city, and Levi, Dolgeville; also 16 grandchildren.

The funeral will be held from the home, 322 West Main Street Saturday afternoon at 2.
