Edwin E. Guild, Sailor, Succumbs After Heart Attack

MIDDLEPORT—Edwin E. Guild, 40, yeoman 1.C., United States Navy, of the Naval and Marine Corps Reserve Training Center, 3 Porter Ave., Buffalo, died Saturday morning (May 11, 1957) in the Veterans Hospital, Buffalo, where he was taken following a heart attack suffered on the way from his home, Alfred St., Middleport, to Buffalo.

He was born Dec. 24, 1916 in Medina but had always lived in this vicinity. Mr. Guild attended the First Universalist Church and served in World War II and had been in Naval service for 12 years.

Survivors include his wife, Dorothy Bacon Guild, Alfred St., Middleport; three sons, Richard, Athens, O., and Daniel and Rory Lee, both at home; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Eugene Guild, Middleport; two sisters, Mrs. John Kriner, Allentown, Pa., and Miss Bernice Guild, Middleport.

Wood of the Universalist Church officiating. Burial will be in Royalton Mountain Ridge Cemetery.
