Eugene Guild, 82, Lodge Member, Dies

MIDDLEPORT—A retired painter, Eugene Guild, 82, of 5 Washington St., died Wednesday evening (June 25, 1958) in the Casey Nursing Home, Medina, where he had been a patient for three days.

He was born August 2, 1875, in the Town of Lyndon, the son of Frank and Alice Wildrigh Guild. He was a member of the I.O.O.F. for 61 years and was a past noble grand of the Middleport Lodge.
