Mrs. R. Gunnison, Widow of Banker

Funeral services for Mrs. Rose Fancher Gunnison, 77, widow of Frederic E. Gunnison, the well-known Brooklyn banker and lawyer, will be conducted at 2 p.m. tomorrow in All Souls Universalist Church, Ocean and Ditmas Aves., by the Rev. Dr. Cornelius Greenway, pastor. Interment will be private in Green-wood Cemetery.

Mrs. Gunnison, who lived at 1065 Lexington Ave., Manhattan, died yesterday after a long illness in the Fifth Avenue Hospital, Manhattan. She was born in Meridian, N.Y. Her husband, a cousin of Raymond M. Gunnison, former vice president of the Brooklyn Eagle, was vice president and a director of the Lawyers Title & Trust Company at the time of his death in 1922. Her father-in-law, the late Almon Gunnison, president of St. Lawrence University, was earlier pastor of All Souls Church.

Mrs. Gunnison was a former resident of Brooklyn for many years.

Surviving are her daughter, Mrs. Oliver D. Appleton, and three grandchildren, Joan, Frederic and Charles.
