Former Resident of Lockport Died At Middleport Home

Herman Gursslin died Thursday [27 Dec 1928] at his late home on Sleeper street. He was born in Germany, November 18, 1864, and at the age of four years came to this country, settling in Lockport. He married Miss Viola Austin, of Shelby, September 26, 1880. Five children were born to them, of whom three survive: Squire, Orville, and Dewitt Gursslin, of Middleport. He also leaves his widow; a brother, Henry Gursslin of Middleport; four sisters, Mrs. Carrie Bartel, Mrs. Fredericka Fisher, of Lockport, Mrs. Minnie Bartel, of Gettsville, and Mrs. William Hartley, of the Mountain road, and thirteen grandchildren.

Mr. Gursslin was a well known farmer and for a number of years conducted a milk route in the village. The funeral was held Sunday afternoon with services at the home and burial at East Shelby. The Rev. C. [Clarence] J. Cowling [Universalist] officiated.
