FREDERICK HAAS DIES SUDDENLY
Well Known Dolgeville Man Passes Away After Short Illness

DOLGEVILLE—Frederick Haas died very suddenly Sunday evening at 6 P.M. at his home on Helmer avenue at the age of 72 years. Mr. Haas became ill around 11 Saturday night but none of the members of his family suspected the end would be near. The deceased came here from Germany 49 years ago and lived here ever since, having been employed by the Daniel Green Company until about six years ago. In 1870 he came a volunteer fireman. He was an industrious man of pleasant disposition. The survivors are his wife, who was Margaret Habelt; two sons, Leo of this village and Frederick of Schenectady; one daughter, Mrs. Floyd Johnson of Philadelphia; two grandchildren, and two sisters, Mrs. Christine Barber and Mrs. J. Feitz of Brooklyn. The funeral will be held on Wednesday afternoon at 2:30 at the house, Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton of the Universalist church officiating. The body will be placed in the vault in the local cemetery for interment in the Spring.
