FORT PLAIN, Nov. 3.—The death of John Hagy, which occurred at the Ellis hospital in Schenectady late Thursday night has caused deep regret among his friends in this village. Mr. Hagy was 33 years of age and was an exceptionally robust young man, judging from outward appearances. For several days he had been employed by George R. Chriss. Wednesday, when his day's work was done, he went home and as he stood talking to his mother he was taken suddenly ill. Dr. Jackson was called and relieved his sufferings as much as possible, and on Thursday morning he was taken to the Schenectady hospital for an operation. It was found that he had been suffering with ulcers of the stomach. Mr. Hagy was born at Salt Springville, Otsego county, and when a boy came to this village with his parents, where he has since resided. He was unusually fond of his family life and had good habits. At different times he had served as substitute policeman and this year could have been regularly appointed to the position had he cared to accept. Besides his mother, he is survived by one brother and a sister, Mrs. William Gottung of Nelliston. The funeral will be held at the home of his sister, Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. Herbert Frank Moulton, D.D., pastor of the Universalist church officiating. The interment will be in the Fort Plain cemetery.
