Her father, Mr. Orion Haight, is now left alone, Mrs. Haight having died several years ago. He has the sympathy of all. The funeral was held Sunday at the Universalist church of which she was a member, Rev. C. H. Vail conducting the service. The church overflowed, many being obliged to remain outside.
