Oliver Hall, 75, whose death Wednesday at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Roy Lahsesr in Germantown, Columbia County, was reported briefly in last night's issue, was born in Starkville, N.Y., the son of John Hall and Marietta Springer.

He had been in failing health for ten years with a complication of diseases which caused his death. He had made his home with his daughter for six years.

Mr. Hall was a member of the Universalist church of Herkimer, and at one time was affiliated with Mohawk Lodge, I.O.O.F.

During his early life he was engaged in farming but later removed to Herkimer where he was employed at the Gem Mill. He had also been employed by the Duofold Company in Mohawk and the Remington Arms and Typewriter Companies.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Eugenia Rockefeller Hall, employed as housekeeper at the home of Deputy County Treasurer E.D. Gordon in this city; another daughter, Mrs. George Sexton, Herkimer; one sister, Mrs. Jesse [sic] Laning, Johnstown; two grandchildren and one niece.

The funeral will be held at the A.G. Cole Funeral Home tomorrow afternoon at 2. The Rev. Harlow W. Parsons of the Baptist church will officiate. Burial will be made in Fort Plain cemetery.
