ERNEST C. HALLOCK

MATAMORAS—Ernest C. Hallock died this morning at his home at Avenue M and 5th street after a brief illness. He was seventy-one years old.

Born in Monroe in 1875, he was the son of Martha Matilda and William Hallock. He spent most of his life in Middletown and was a member of the Universalist Church, Wallkill [sic] Council, Junior Order of United American Mechanics, a fifty year member of the Waalkill Engine Company, Camp Thirty-Eight POA and a veteran of World War I. He moved to Matamoras fifteen years ago.

He is survived by his wife, the former Elizabeth A. Wilson, a son, Stephen C. Hallock, and two nephews, William Lamoreaux of Matamoras and Ernest Lamoreaux of Pittsburgh.

Last year Mr. and Mrs. Hallock celebrated their fiftieth wedding anniversary.

Funeral services will be held Sunday at two o'clock at the Terwilliger and Woolsey Chapel. Burial will be in the Hillside Cemetery, Middletown.
