DEATH OF STEPHEN HALLOCK

The death of Stephen Hallock, aged 85 years, occurred in his farm home, one mile south of Albion, Saturday night. Mr. Hallock was one of Orleans county's wealthiest capitalists and for many years was a prize stock exhibitor. He was a lifelong resident of Barre and Albion.

Born in the town of Barre, March 17, 1830, Mr. Hallock was educated in the rural district schools of that town. He moved to his Albion farm about fifty years ago, and had lived there since that time.

He was a director in the Albion Cold Storage Company and was largely interested in other enterprises. Mr. Hallock leaves only his wife. The funeral will be held from the farm home, one mile south of Albion, Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, Rev. Charles H. Vail [Universalist] officiating. Burial will be in Mount Albion Cemetery.

The deceased was a brother of the late William Hallock, concerning whose property there was so much litigation two years ago.
