MRS. MARY HALSEY FUNERAL TUESDAY
Lifetime Resident of Whitesville Died at Home of Daughter in Hornell
at the age of 83 Years—Burial here Tuesday

After an illness of some six weeks of a complication of diseases due to age, Mrs. Mary Halsey, widow of the late Albert Halsey, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Afton Knapp in Hornell, Saturday, February 1st, 1930 in the 84th year of her life.

Mary Katherine Moses was born at Geneva, N.Y., but came here with her parents when they moved to Whitesville where her father conducted a jewelry store. Her first marriage was to Michael Carpenter and to them were born five children: Mrs. Willet Harris of Whitesville, Mrs. A. B. Payne of Genesee and Mrs. Afton Knapp of Hornell, who survive with one sister Mrs. Sarah Coykendall of Hornell and a brother Cyrus Moses of Stanards. Two other children, Mrs. DeEtte Hile and Cass Carpenter are deceased. Her second marriage was to Albert Halsey, deceased.

Funeral services were held from Whitesville Universalist Church of which Mrs. Halsey was a member at 11:30 a.m. on February 4th, 1930. The Rev. Wm. E. Todd of Woodbury Universalist church in Hornell, officiating. Interment was in the family plot in Rural cemetery.
