GLENN HARDY, 68, DIES WEDNESDAY

Glen Samuel Hardy, 68, son of the late Oliver and Jane Phippen Hardy died Wednesday afternoon, October 11th at his home here after being in frail health for several months.

Mr. Hardy was born July 29, 1882 on the farm established by his parents and had always lived here with his sister, Mrs. Gayle Kent. He was a member of the Winthrop Universalist church since 1921.

Surviving besides his sister, Mrs. Kent are one niece, Mrs. William (Shirley) Jenkins, Woodside, L. I., two nephews, Tech. Sgt. Hardy Kent of Washington, D. C., and Captain Mark Kent stationed in Paris, France; an aunt, Miss Lois Hardy, Lexington, Mass., three grandnieces and two grandnephews.

Funeral services were held at the home Friday at 2 00 p.m. with Fred Russell, student pastor at Winthrop Congregational Church officiating. Burial was in the Union cemetery in Buckton.
