News of Macedon

Macedon, Oct. 11—Noah Wood Hare passed away Tuesday evening at his home on Main street. He had been in failing health for many months. He was born in Duanesburg, Schoharie Co., Aug. 3, 1838, and came to Macedon with his parents while an infant. He was married to Cynthia B. Beal on Oct. 11, 1865. Ten children were born to them, eight of whom are still living, and all were present at the funeral, which was held on Thursday of last week. On Oct. 11, 1915, Mr. and Mrs. Hare celebrated their Golden wedding. He was a charter member of Macedon Lodge, F. & A.M., also a member of Palmyra Lodge, Palmyra Eagle Chapter, Zenobia Commandery. He leaves his wife; three daughters, Mrs. Sarah Ballard of Utica, Mrs. Cora Ransom of Macedon, Mrs. Beulah Fowler of Worcester, Mass.; five sons, Ira Hare of Poughkeepsie, Edward, Herbert and Harrison Hare, of Worcester, Mass., Shirley D. Hare of Macedon. The funeral, which was private, was held Thursday afternoon, Rev. A. [Adelbert] E. Allison [minister of the Universalist Church] officiating.
