Charles Morris Harman, a retired professional music instructor, for the past three years organist of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of the Covenant, Catalpa and Anta avenues, Ridgewood, died suddenly on Sunday of heart disease at his home, 67 Nostrand place, Richmond Hill. He was born in Baltimore, Md., seventy-one years ago and had lived in Greater New York for forty-five years.
