CITY EMPLOYEE FOUND DEAD

Thomas Harney, 59, a city employe[e], was found dead in bed by his wife shortly after 12 a.m. Wednesday at his home, 1317 S. State st.

Mrs. Harney at once called a physician, who pronounced him dead. A permission autopsy was performed at the morgue.

Mr. Harney had been in the employ of the public works department of the city for a number of years. He appeared at his work Tuesday in his usual state of health.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Nellie Harney; one brother, James Harney; also one sister, Mrs. Aaron Kilburn.

Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock in the Fancher undertaking parlors, 514 W. Onondaga st. Burial will be in Onondaga Hill Cemetery. Rev. Frederick W. Betts [minister of the First Universalist Church] will officiate.
