OBITUARY.

Almon M. Hoskins [Haskins] died at his home adjoining the home of Albert S. Brainard, in Wirt, last Friday night. He would have been 87 years old in October next. He was born in Jefferson county and has been a resident of Friendship and vicinity for 64 years, with the exception of a few years in Pennsylvania. When we first knew him he occupied the farm owned by Mrs. Andrew McCarthy. He was married 53 years ago last January to Miss Lucy Scott, sister to Asa Scott. Four children survive: Morris E. Haskins, of Mantua, O., Geo. A. Haskins, of Guffy, Pa., Arthur A. Haskins, of Emlenton, Pa., and Mrs. Mary Brainard. He had fourteen grandchildren. He was buried in Maple Grove cemetery from the Universalist church in Friendship last Sunday, many of his former acquaintances and friends following his remains to the grave.
