## LYMAN G. HAZELTON DIES AT SPRAGUEVILLE

GOUVERNEUR, Dec. 18.—Lyman Gillette<sup>1</sup> Hazelton, 80, died at his home in Spragueville at 4:30 o'clock Wednesday morning. Mr. Hazelton was born on the Antwerp turnpike in the town of Antwerp, June 15, 1844, son of James and Almira Wight Hazelton. He had resided his entire life in the vicinity of his birth until a few years ago, when he retired from active farming and moved to Spragueville.

Mr. Hazelton married Miss Ella Austin in 1876, who survives. Other survivors are: one son, J. Mortimer Hazelton, of this village; three daughters, Miss Mildred Hazelton of Spragueville, Mrs. Lucille Brown, Antwerp, and Mrs. Raymond Downing of Macomb; also one sister, Mrs. James Donally of Chicago. Funeral will be held at his home Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Rev. Harry Westbrook, pastor of the Universalist church in Watertown, will officiate, and the body will be brought to Gouverneur for burial in Riverside cemetery.
