Death of Mrs. G. M. Helmer

Mrs. G. Monroe Helmer, a most estimable lady, died at her home in North Main street Tuesday last. Deceased was born in the town of Columbia, January 14, 1839, and was the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Leonard [and Mary Haner] Brown. On December 22, 1867, she was united in marriage to G. [George] Monroe Helmer, and until the angel of death came, the two had lived a life of companionship and happiness. She had always resided in this section and for the past forty-eight years had lived in the home where she passed away. She was a woman universally respected by all who knew her. She was a member of the Universalist Church and active in all its branches. There survive none except the sorely bereaved husband and one cousin. To the husband the heartfelt sympathy of the community go [goes] out in his great loss. The funeral was attended from the home Friday afternoon, Rev. F. [Frank] O. Hokerk officiating.
