Wm. Henderson, who was released from his suffering Sunday afternoon, was 86 years of age and had lived in this vicinity the greater part of his life. He was at one time engaged in the mercantile business with J. F. Gray, and later was sole proprietor of the business when his store and stock of goods were burned, after which he engaged in speculations. In early life he married Miss Harmony Brockway and one daughter was born to them. Thirty-five years ago he was again married to Miss Eliza Kinney who has been untiring in her constant care of him in his declining years when life had become a burden. Besides his wife, he leaves his daughter, Mrs. Geo. Robinson of West Burlington, three grandchildren and six great-grandchildren. He was a member of the Universalist church. The funeral will be held Thursday at 1 o'clock at the house and 2 o'clock at the church, Rev. F. O. Hokerk officiating.
