Mrs. Eliza Herkimer Dies at Home of Her Son at Mohawk

MOHAWK, June 24.—Shortly after midnight at the home of her son, Warren E. Herkimer, West Main Street, occurred the death of Mrs. Eliza Herkimer, widow of Seneca Herkimer. The end came after a four-months period of illness and resulted from complications incident to her advanced age, she being in her eighty-first year.

She was a native of Otsego County. She was born April 19, 1841 at Springfield, being the daughter of the late Peter and Magdalena Young. Her marriage to her late husband, Seneca Herkimer, took place at Cooperstown, October 2, 1861. Five years later they removed to Brooklyn, where Mr. Herkimer engaged in business and they resided there until his death 11 years ago.

Since the death of her husband she divided her time between the homes of her sons Warren and Dr. Robert Herkimer, until the death of the latter four years ago.

She was an attendant of the Universalist Church and possessed many fine qualities which caused her to be loved and esteemed by all who knew her.

Surviving are her son Warren; a brother, Cyrus Young of Ryley, Alberta, Canada; a granddaughter, Olivia Herkimer Dauchy of Brooklyn, and a great granddaughter, Ann Elizabeth.
