ALBERT C. HICKCOX

Albert C. Hickcox, lifelong resident of Friendship died at the home of his son, Earle E. Hickcox, Saturday morning, Jan. 12. He was 77 years old.

He was born in Friendship on April 7, 1857, son of John and Abigail Leonard Hickcox. He was married Feb. 2, 1879, to Henrietta Bolsover, who survives him. A daughter, Mrs. C. R. Stout of Franklinville and a son, Earle E. Hickcox of this place, and three grandchildren, also survive him.

Mr. Hickcox was a past noble grand of the VanCampen Lodge, I.O.O.F., a charter officer and past president of the Corbin Hose Company, member of the Old Timers' Association, etc. Until his health began to fail he was always active in the industrial and social life of the community.

Funeral services were held from the home of the son Monday afternoon, the Rev. Otis F. Alvord [Universalist] officiating. Burial was in the family lot in Mount Hope cemetery.
