## BERNICE K. HICKCOX

Miss Bernice K. Hickcox, daughter of Ernest L. Hickcox of Friendship, passed away at the Essex Mountain Sanitarium, Verona, New Jersey, last Thursday forenoon. Nearly two years ago Miss Hickcox, while employed at the Essex County Hospital, New Jersey, suffered a breakdown in health and became a patient in the sanitarium.

The body was brought to her home on West Main Street, Friendship, where funeral services were held Saturday afternoon, December 3rd. The Rev. L. M. F.
