ERNEST L. HICKCOX

In the early hours of Friday morning, May 18, Ernest Linwood Hickcox passed away after several years of slowly failing health. He was 74 years of age.

Funeral services were held at the residence on West Main street, this village, at 2:30 Sunday afternoon, conducted by the Rev. Otis F. Alvord [Universalist], a lifelong friend of the departed. Burial was in Mount Hope cemetery in the family plot. Bearers were Past Noble Grands of VanCampen Lodge, No. 258, I.O.O.F.: William A. Stevens, Ephriam L. Blank, John J. Thurston, J. Richard Stone, Sidney C. Barnes and Clifford D. Lyon.

Mr. Hickcox was born on the site of the present home on June 15, 1859, oldest son of John S. and Abigail Leonard Hickcox. He was a resident of Friendship his entire life, following the trade of wagon maker. He was a member and Past Noble Grand of VanCampen Lodge, I.O.O.F., an exempt member of the Friendship Fire Department and charter member of the H. A. Corbin Hose company.

He was married on October 28, 1885, to Miss Esther Isolina Whipple who preceded him in death on January 7, 1925.

He is survived by one brother, Albert C. Hickcox of this place and several nephews and nieces: Robert J. and Miss Francis [sic] Helme of Friendship, Mrs. Fred Bigelow of Arkansas Pass, Texas, Mrs. Charles R. Stout of Franklinville, Fred Kellogg of San Diego, Cal., Roy Kellogg of Palo Alto, Cal., and Earl E. Hitchcox of this place.
