Burial of Infant Daughter

The funeral of the infant daughter [Fern F., age about 6 months] of Mr. and Mrs. Oscar [and Mary] Hicks who died Tuesday evening, was held from the family home Thursday afternoon, Rev. Thomas J. Farmer, pastor of the Universalist church at Cortland conducting the service. His remarks were full of words of comfort for the grief-stricken parents, who had been bereft of their loved one thus early in life. He endeavored to console them with the assurance that their darling had been safely gathered as a lamb into the fold, where it would go out no more forever.

The floral tributes were beautiful and there was a profusion which were arranged about the room. The funeral was private, only the relatives and immediate friends of the family being present. Interment was made at Groton.
